Entries & Acceptance

No Entry For Exhibition Only

No entry "For Exhibition Only" shall be accepted, except as provided for in Chapter 10 when Intro Program classes are offered. See additional note for club policy regarding dogs that measure up.

General Rule on Eligibility

This event is sanctioned by the United States Dog Agility Association, Inc. ("USDAA").

This test is open to all persons with dogs being at least 18 months of age (14 months of age pursuant to Chapter 10 for Intro Program when offered OR for Sanctioned Match), regardless of pedigree or absence thereof, who have a current registration with USDAA and whose owners and the dog's handler are currently in good standing with USDAA.

Policy on Refusal of Entry

The Organizing Committee of an event may refuse the entry of any competitor or dog for just cause should the Committee view that participation by the competitor or dog could be prejudicial to the sport. However, in such case, the Committee must notify the competitor in writing upon receipt of entry, but in no case, more than three days following the event closing date for acceptance of entries. The burden of responsibility for the appropriateness of such action rests solely with the host group and its Organizing Committee.

NSF Check/Credit Card

Any check or credit card that is charged back by the bank or other financial institution may be assessed a service charge of up to \$40 per incident at the discretion of the host group.

Returned checks or credit card returns do not constitute a valid entry. Amounts shall be paid within 30 day of postmarked notice of the returned payment if such date follows the event date. Any fees not received within 30 days of notice will result in cancellation of event results for all classes related to the entry for which payment was made. No reinstatement of results is possible, and all awards must be returned within 10 days of notification or the dog's registration may be suspended pending restitution.

Any unpaid fees or shortfalls must be paid prior to the start of the event, or entry is canceled without recourse.

Refund Policy

There shall be NO REFUNDS for entries withdrawn after the closing date for acceptance of entries, for absentee, dismissal from the event as a result of disciplinary action, dismissal from a class, or for any other reason. Also, no entry fees will be refunded if the event cannot open or be completed by reason of riots, civil disturbances, acts of terrorism, fire, "act of God", public emergency, strike, or any other cause beyond the control of the host organization.

Provisional Entries / Bye Vouchers

> If entered in GP/PGP Regional Championships provisionally and have earned a bye voucher since closing you MUST present the voucher to the trial secretary on Thursday. All bye vouchers must accompany entry forms if earned prior to closing of this event.

> Please write a separate check for each provision entry for each dog.

Example: Spot is entered in Biathlon, Grand Prix and Team, but provisionally in Steeplechase Regional. Write a check for all classes Spot is qualified to

enter and a separate check for Spot's Steeplechase entry.

> Should your provisionally entered dog qualify on Thursday, you must complete a PROVISIONAL MOVE-UP form at the score table.

Submission of Entries with Secondary Move-Up Date

All entries or cancellations must be received at the Secretary's address no later than the closing date, after which time no entries will be accepted or cancelled. For entries received by the closing date, the level of entry into a given class may be advanced by notifying the Secretary in writing via email by the "Secondary Closing Date". No other changes, cancellations or additions may be made after the initial closing date.

To be accepted, entries must be complete, signed (by parent or legal guardian if handler is a minor), received by the closing date and accompanied by the correct fees and include a valid USDAA registration number on a completed registration form.

Next-Day Move-Ups Allowed At This Event

Competitors earning a qualification during the Event that is needed to complete a title may advance their level THE NEXT DAY at the same event, i.e. move-ups on consecutive days ARE allowed.

Competitors are responsible for keeping accurate records of their qualifying scores and the judges from whom these scores were earned prior to this event to ensure that the dog is eligible to move up based upon scores earned at this Event. Competitors are advised to confirm scores earned with the scorekeeper and judge at the conclusion of a class to ensure the qualifying score has been accurately calculated and awarded in accordance with regulations. If for any reason it is determined that the score or previous scores were inaccurate, making the entry ineligible for the higher level class, any results (including awards) shall be forfeited and the entry will be deemed invalid without refund or other recourse.

Move-up forms supplied by this event must be used to notify the secretary BEFORE she leaves the site the day on which you earn your title.

Regional - Provisional GP/PGP/STP/PSJ Entries

Provisional entries will be accepted for competitors who have not earned a qualifying score prior to the closing date, which is required for entry to the Regional classes for Grand Prix, Performance Grand Prix, Steeplechase and Performance Speed Jumping. Qualifying opportunity in the Grand Prix/PGP or STP/PSJ through local qualifiers is offered at this Regional Championship event.

A separate payment for provisional entry fees to the tournament classes is required and must be designated on the Entry Form, or such payment will be nonrefundable should the dog not be eligible to run.

Check-in & Measuring

Dog Measurements & Certification

All dogs not jumping 24" in the Championship Program or 20" in the Performance Program at local and regional events must be measured unless they have permanent USDAA or World Cynosport Dog Registration status or a temporary card with 3 signatures as required by the regulations, making the dog eligible for their jump height (prior to 3 years of age). Please note that only dogs 18 months of age and entered in the event may be officially measured.

A Dog that Measures Up at Check-In FEO Not Allowed

If a judge's measurement of a dog at check-in establishes that the dog is ineligible for the height class in which entered, the competitor may

- Run the dog at the higher height in the same program based upon the measurement,
- Modify the entry to enroll the dog in the proper height class in the Performance Program,
- Modify the entry to enroll the dog in the proper height class in the Veterans Program if the dog is 8 years old

Dogs may NOT run For Exhibition Only (FEO) at this event.

Because entry into a higher height is permitted in the Performance and Championship Programs, a dog measuring lower may not be moved to a lower height in either program.

Regional - Special Measuring

Any dog entered in tournaments that does not have a completed registration card, i.e. three measurements that place the dog in a specific jump height, must be measured prior to competing at a Regional Championship event or Cynosport® World Games in order to confirm that the dog is eligible for the height entered.

If the dog measures up, the competitor must jump the dog at the higher jump height in all classes regardless of the jump height in which the dog earned its qualifications. If the competitor had a bye at the lower height, the bye is forfeited, and the competitor must compete in all rounds that may have been bypassed as a result of the bye.

General Entry Conditions

Prohibitions on Aids & Devices

No leads, collars, food, toys or other aids or devices shall be permitted on the course at any time, except as provided for in Chapter 10 when Intro Program classes are offered, or in Chapter 8 when Junior Handler Program classes are offered.

Statement of Responsibility

Competitors alone are responsible for the behavior of themselves, their dogs, children, and guests. A competitor whose dogs, children or guests create unnecessary disturbances or repeatedly engage in unsafe or disruptive behavior may, at the discretion of the Event Organizing Committee, be asked to leave the test site.

Policy on Fault Limits

In the event of a larger entry, fault limits may be set at the discretion of the Organizing Committee and/or Judge without pre-event notice.

Spam Blocker

Confirmations will be sent via email using the secretary's address. If you have a spam blocker on your email account, please configure it to allow email from the secretary's address since confirmations will be sent from this account.

Bitches In Season Allowed at This Regional

Masters Challenge Biathlon - Concurrent Titling Scores

The Masters Challenge (MC) & Performance Masters Challenge (PMC) Biathlon tournaments each consists of two classes; Standard and Jumpers. In addition to the combined score of these two classes being scored for tournament qualification purposes, each class will be scored independently in order to determine if title qualification has been earned for the MC and PMC standard and jumpers classes.

Titling Class Rules & Descriptions

One or more titling classes shall be held at this Event from those described in Chapters 3 - 8 of USDAA Official Rules & Regulations, which are downloadable from www.usdaa.com/rulesReg_eBook.cfm, and any amendments there to, which are downloadable from www.usdaa.com/rulesReg.cfm, each of which are hereby incorporated by reference.

Tournament Class Rules & Descriptions

One or more tournament classes are being held at this event, the rules and description of which may be downloaded on the Internet at www.usdaa.com/gen_formDoc.cfm, and are hereby incorporated by reference. A written copy may be obtained from the Event secretary.

Team & Versatility Pairs Measure-up Policy

The handler of a dog entered in Team or Versatility Pairs must notify the secretary immediately should their dog be required to jump a higher height by virtue of the judge's measurement. The dog must jump the higher jump height in order to be eligible to earn a qualifying score in the tournament. If entered in Team, the dog may not be moved to Versatility Pairs. If the handler chooses **not** to have their dog jump the higher height, their entry is effectively withdrawn. The competitor may or may not run for exhibition only (earning no qualifications) solely at the discretion of the event secretary; there shall be no refund of fees paid.

If the change in height makes the dog ineligible for their team (three jump heights), the secretary will make every effort to form complete teams from dogs available. A move-up in height for dogs in Versatility Pairs does not affect their team composition, but may result in a change in their position in the running order because of the height composition of the Pair.

Prizes & Awards

Regional Prizes and Awards

Titling and Tournament Local Qualifier

Titling Classes, Local GP/PGP and STP/PSJ

- First through fourth place rosettes will be awarded in each jump height for all classes, except Pairs where ribbons will be awarded to mini and open classes
- A Maroon qualifying ribbon will be awarded to those achieving a qualifying score in a test class. Titling ribbons will be awarded to those finishing a title.
- Grand Prix/Perf Grand Prix: First through fourth place rosettes will be awarded in each jump height. A maroon ribbon will be awarded to those achieving a qualifying score. A Regional Championship bye voucher - which may be used at this regional - will be awarded to the first place qualifier in each jump height.
- Steeplechase/PSJ: A maroon ribbon will be awarded those achieving a qualifying score. There is a single round; prize money will be added to Regional.

Regional Classes

- Grand Prix/Perf. Grand Prix Round 1 - Q ribbons for a qualifying score.
- GP/PGP Round 2 - first through third placements and medals for each jump height. Regional champion trophy awarded to first place for each jump height. All dogs earning a bye into the semifinals at Cynosport will receive a bye certificate.
- Steeplechase/Perf Speed Jumping Round 2: first through third placements and medals for each jump height. Regional Champion trophy awarded to first place for each jump height. Prize money shall be awarded based on 40% of the entry fees from BOTH Round 1 of the local Steeplechase/PSJ and Round 1 of the Regional Steeplechase/PSJ. All dogs earning a bye into the semifinals at Cynosport will receive a bye certificate.
- Team/PVP: first through third placements/medals for overall in each tournament. Trophy for 1st overall for each tournament.
- Biathlon: first through third placements and medals for each jump height. Regional Champion trophy awarded to first place for each jump height.

Bitches in Season (BIS)

Bitches in Season (BIS) will be allowed to compete at the event. The owner shall notify the trial secretary by email if their dog will be in season and attending the trial.

Pursuant to USDAA policy, they must wear sanitary panties (britches) at all times on the show ground as well as when running in the ring. BIS will run in order of the assigned position in the running order.

Any competitor with a male that feels that a bitch in heat right in front of their dog or right behind in the running order will disturb their run may move their male. (Exception is Masters/P3 Snooker where you must run in published order.)

BIS dogs must be crated away from the general population and cannot be out walking around on the grounds or in the stands unless they are getting ready to run or out to potty. Failure to comply with these rules and the owner and BIS will be asked to leave and no refund will be given. We ask you be respectful of the other dogs at the show.
